CALL MY BLUFF

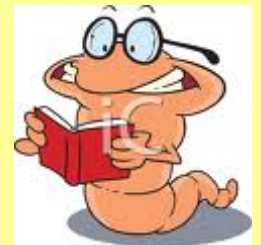
