The tournament

- Beginning in 1939 Rosslyn Park is not only the oldest continuous tournament but has also evolved into the world's largest rugby tournament with some 7,000 boys and girls aged 13 - 18 competing.
- Organisers have developed a policy during the past years to invite schools from overseas who may be touring the UK to play in the tournament.
- In 1998 the first girls (U18) competition was inaugurated.
- A significant number of England internationals tasted competitive rugby for the first time at the tournament.
- Will Carling, Neil Back and Lawrence Dallaglio are just some England stars who have played in the tournament.



- Any souvenirs or merchandise



Travel

- In groups of 3 or more at all times. We must wear a red trips lanyard.

Kit List and Nutrition



Travel – Travel in full school uniform (apart from u14 girls)

Match day – Boots, mouth guard, socks, shorts, KCC Rugby Top, base layer, waterproof top, jumper, tracksuit bottoms. Risk of valuables being taken during tournament. **You must have kit for all weathers.**

Additional – Wash bag, towel, swim kit, causal clothes for the team meal. I would also pack a wet flannel/towel and full change for the bus home. **We normally have some money left to cover food on the way home but it would be worth having some money for additional snacks etc.**

Nutrition –Meals included Evening meal, breakfast and lunch.

As you will have games throughout the day we will have a good breakfast and the rest of the day will be snacking.

Food to include: fruits, cereal bars, sandwiches. Key part of the day will be taking on enough water

Food to avoid: Too much caffeine, refined sugars, proteins that are hard to digest.
